

## Vikings and Dragons 3

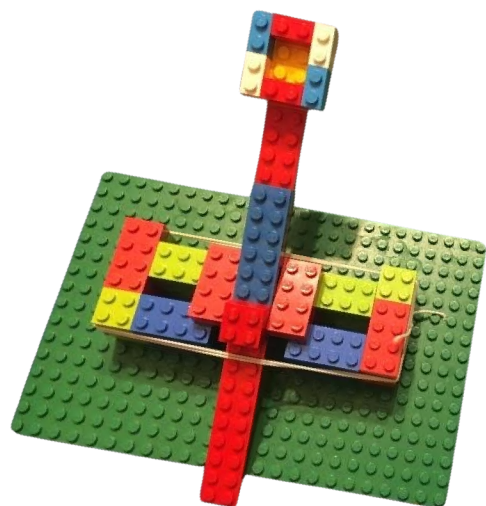
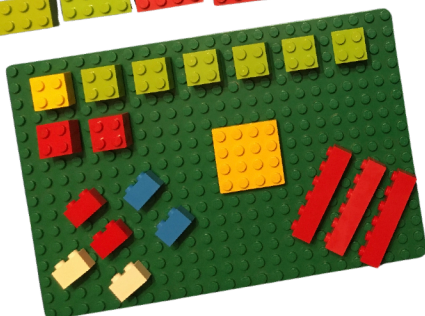
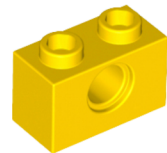
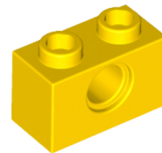


Catapults (or trebuchet) were originally developed by the ancient Greeks and Romans, but the Vikings borrowed and adapted them for attacking castles! Our more friendly Lego Vikings going to use a catapult to feed the dragons or play a game!

In this session, your children's challenge is to build a Lego catapult. It should be able to launch small, light weight objects such as popcorn or tiny crumpled paper balls.

Suggested elements:

- Baseboard
- Bricks
- Narrow plates
- Technic brick with pins and 2 x Technic bricks with holes
- Elastic bands
- Paper balls or popcorn
